Mission Trip

In just over 15 weeks our missionaries will be embarking on KACS's first mission trip. Students, families, and staff, working with International Children's Care, are headed to a very impoverished, rural, area north of San Salvador. The trip will take place from March 20 to April 1, 2024. While there the missionaries will help build a simple church. Mr. Reyes reports that the people in this rural area are "extremely poor, with no means whatsoever. They have no modern conveniences, no electricity, no water, and no money." However, they long to worship God in a church. Mr. Reyes says, "If we do not do it (build), they will not ever be able to complete such a project."
